Experience what it's like to cook food in a hot spring (Jigokumushi).

D One of Kyushu's largest ropeways, with room for 101 passengers!

At an elevation of 1,375 meters, Mt. Tsurumi can be reached in just 10 minutes via a ropeway from the foot of the mountain. From the peak you can enjoy panoramic views of Beppu, the Kuju Mountains Mt. Yufu, and the Shikoku region. Spring brings cherry blossoms and rhododendron, while summer offers cool weather so that you can escape the heat of lower-lying areas. There's fall foliage to enjoy in the autumn, and then frost in the winter. The *Kyushu Shochu-kan* features a collection of about 500 types of *shochu* liquor and other exhibits from around Kyushu.

- ◆Hours: First departure: 9:00 Last departure: Ascending, 17:00; Descending, 17:30 (Last departure from November 15 to March 14: Ascending, 16:30; Descending, 17:00) *Open year-round. The ropeway closes temporarily from time to time for reasons including inclement weather, equipment maintenance, and inspections.

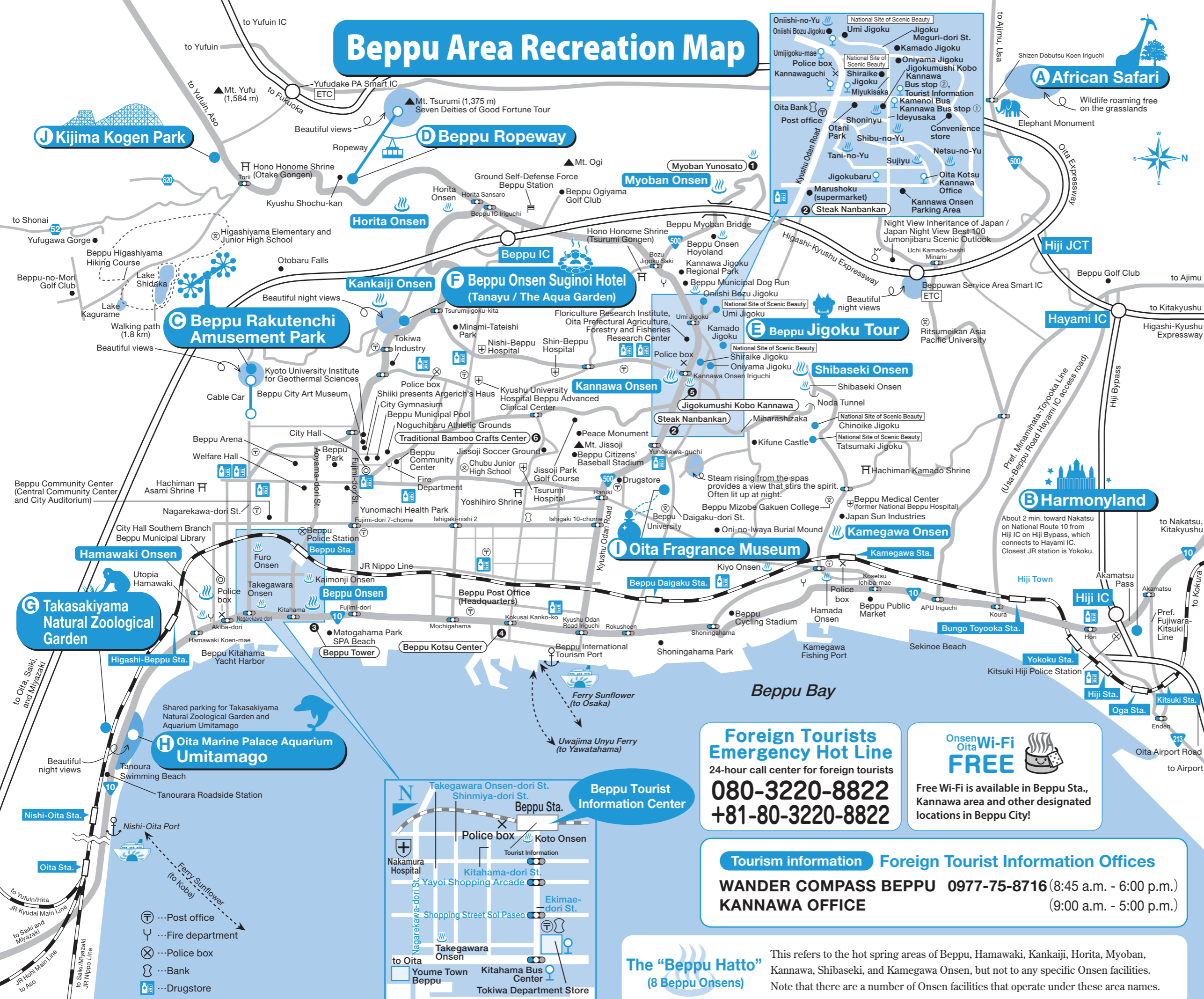

Beppu Area Recreation Map



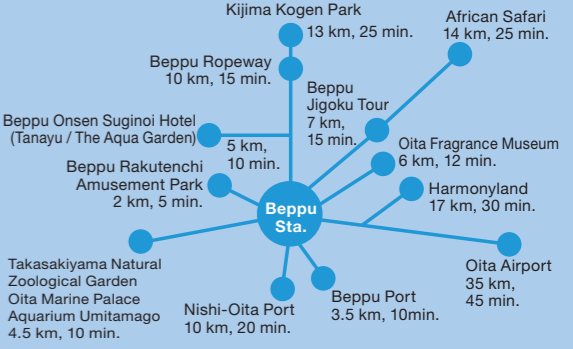
